CAMP STARTS at 9:30 am and ends at 2:30 pm each day.

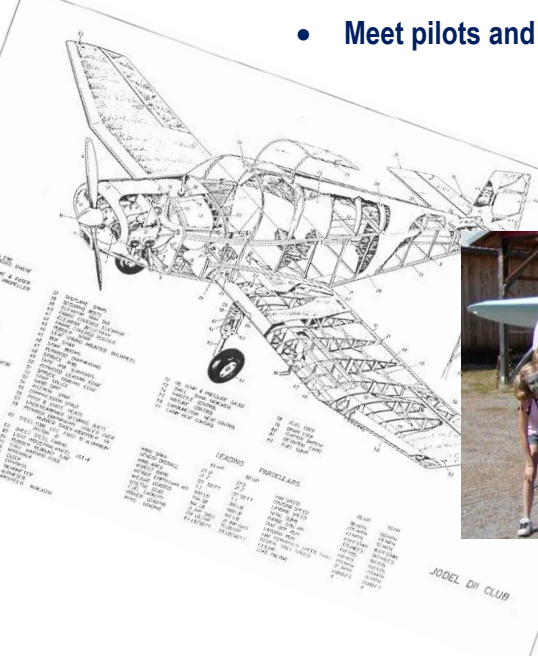
CAMP DROP-OFF: Texada Island Airport, Gillies Bay, Number 8 Hangar

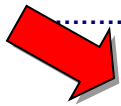
A) YOUTH APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING AND AGREEMENT TO COMPLY
